1. <u>AY 14/15 Updates</u>

- a. Employee Parking
 - Relocated student resident parking to add employee "C" parking along Cates/Morrill Avenue areas
- b. Visitor Parking
 - i. January 2015
 - 1. New pay-by-space metered locations
 - a. Capability South (Centennial)
 - b. West Lot (Main Campus
 - 2. Replaced equipment in Poulton Deck with pay-by-space meters
 - 3. Rate change from \$2/hr and \$10 daily max to \$2 for 1st hr and \$1 for subsequent 30 minutes and \$10 daily max
 - 4. Pay-by-Phone Option through PassPort Parking
- a. Wolfine
 - ii. August 2014
 - 1. Six new buses arrived. Five put in service on Rt 3, Engineering
 - 2. Initiated new route to Centennial Campus from Varsity Drive Lot
 - 3. Added Sunday service to Centennial Campus
 - iii. January 2015 extended evening bus service to Wolf Ridge

2. AY 15/16 - Items Under Review

- a. Parking Fees Under review at this time. 2% was recommended, but conducting review of revenue and expenses to determine actual need, which could be less. Assuming a 2%, rates could fall out as:
 - i. Employee (incl. departmental) between 25¢ and \$1.75 per month, with most employees paying between 50¢ and 75¢ more per month
 - ii. Students between \$2 and \$7 annually
- b. Visitor Parking
 - i. Guest On-line increase from \$2 to \$5 per day
 - ii. Updated Temporary Permits increase from \$5 to \$10 per day
 - iii. Install up to 3 additional pay-by-space meters on campus
- c. Transit Services
 - i. Farmer's Market Park and Ride
 - ii. Realighment of services to Westgrove Park and Ride Lot and Cameron Village
- d. TDM
 - i. Carpools offer discounts for 3-person employee carpools
 - ii. GoPass Program consideration for eliminating \$25 employee registration fee and implementing a small monthly payroll deductible fee
