Current Sanctioning Practices

- First Violation
 - Educational activities
 - Grade penalty
 - Al probation throughout academic career
 - Suspension*

- Second Violation
 - Educational activities
 - Grade penalty
 - Suspension

Proposal Rationale

The Office of Student Conduct will administer sanctions for students found responsible for academic misconduct violations. The considerations outlined in the following slides reflect sanctions that **should be considered** for academic misconduct cases. **The hearing officer for each case has the discretion to deviate from the considerations below based on aggravating or mitigating factors**. The purpose of creating this proposal is to **instill a greater focus on education** for students referred for academic misconduct and to give hearing officers **more flexibility and discretion** when deciding cases.

Proposed Sanctioning Changes

First Incident w/o aggravating factors

- Grade Penalty
- Al Module/Wellness Coaching
- Academic Integrity Probation for 1 year

First Incident w/aggravating factors

- Grade Penalty
- AI Module/Wellness Coaching
- Academic Integrity Probation for specified time period longer ≥1 year or for remainder of academic career
- Suspension (min. one term)

Proposed Sanctioning Changes

Second Incident w/o aggravating factors & AI probation has expired

- •Grade Penalty
- •Al Module/Wellness Coaching
- Academic Integrity Probation for specified time period longer ≥1 year or for remainder of academic career
- •Suspension (min. one term)

Second Incident <u>while on Al</u> <u>probation</u>

- •Grade Penalty
- Other Educational Sanctions (if AI Module/Wellness Coaching previously completed)
- Academic Integrity Probation for remainder of academic career
- •Suspension (min. one term)

Third Incident

- Grade Penalty
- Other Educational Sanctions
- •Academic Integrity Probation for remainder of academic career
- Suspension
- Expulsion
